## **EECVI Reminders for Equine Owners**



Prior to creating a movement permit, observe horse for clinical signs of illness and take temperature to ensure it is below 100.5 degrees F. If horse is healthly and fit to travel, login to MyVetLink to create your EECVI Movement Permits.



A Movement Permit is required for each leg of your trip. Separate movement permits are required for departure and return trips.



A Movement Permit is for the trip on the listed Travel Date only. If you will be traveling to the same destination in the future, you will need to create a new permit.



Movement Permits should be issued within 7 days, ahead of the time of travel.

### **GVL EECVI** - Instructions for Equine Owners

1. When your veterinarian has completed your EECVI, you will receive an email (shown below) from <u>no-reply@globalvetlink.com</u>.



- 2. To begin creating a movement permit, click Create Permit in the email or login to your MyVetLink account.
- 3. After logging into MyVetLink, click on Certificates in the left hand menu. Here you will see the recent certificates that your veterinarian has completed for you. To view your EECVIs only, click the Show EECVIs only button at the top of the screen.
- 4. To create your movement permit, click on the Certificate number and select Create a permit.

6. After clicking Finish Permit you will be prompted to Commit the permit. By doing so, you are verifying that your horse is healthy, that you will travel with your permit and official ID information and that you have been made aware of any travel restrictions. If true, click Commit.

\*Your COGGINS form *must* accompany your EECVI. This is where your horses IDs (if provided to MLVC) are located.

\*Make sure you own a thermometer and can take your horse's temperature
